The TerraMigakiDesign team is pleased to announce its participation in Design Week 2025 with a series of initiatives at Fabbrica del Vapore in Milan, under the title "**RIS-VOLTI MATERICI.**"

Our project is rooted in the valorization of quarry by-products, transforming them into elements of design. We are pleased to **invite** designers, artists, decorators, and graphic designers to contribute by **conceptualizing and creating surfaces for raw earth panels** intended for interior design. Each project should respect the unique characteristics of raw earth, exploring its aesthetic, functional, and technological potentials.

We are seeking innovative proposals that engage in dialogue with the material, also considering aspects of industrialization and reproducibility. Selected participants will have the opportunity to choose from three different participation modes:

1. Pre-Event Production: Creating the panels with our support before the Design Week.
2. Independent Production: Collecting the panels provided by us, working on them independently in your own studio, and returning them by the setup day (April 6th).
3. On-Site Creation: Developing the project during Design Week in a dedicated workshop area adjacent to the exhibition space (Space 1 – CISTERNE Building – Fabbrica del Vapore).

Should you wish to proceed with on-site production during the Design Week, we kindly ask you to notify us in advance.

To participate, please **submit your project proposal** and, if available, a portfolio of previous works related to raw earth to **terramigakidesign@gmail.com** by **March 2, 2025**. The panels to be designed will have standard dimensions of 25x600x1600 mm.

Selected candidates will be contacted by **March 7, 2025**, to finalize participation details.

We believe in the value of material as a language, capable of conveying stories, emotions, and new visions of sustainability. We look forward to receiving your applications and exploring the potential of raw earth together.
